TOTAL OWING

1. ABSOLUTELY NO FLEXI LEADS ALLOWED – shortening and/or locking them is not acceptable. If you arrive with your pet on a flexi lead you will be asked to purchase a nylon leash for your dog.

2. All Dogs **MUST BE** leashed at all times (except in the run)

3. **MUZZLES:** Please muzzle your pet if they get stressed or are reactive to other dogs
MUZZLES MUST BE WORN IN GREYHOUND RUNS

4. What do these mean? Please make yourself aware!

Red Bandanas – stay away – “I’m not good with other dogs”

Yellow Bandanas – caution – “Not too close please, I’m nervous”

Muzzles – should be worn on both of the above.

All of the above are true especially in closed quarters such as vending areas.

If your dog is reactive in either of these please use the tools mentioned

5. When in vending areas please:

- Keep your dog on a short leash beside you at all times. Be aware of what your dog is doing
- Do not allow your pet to lie on the floor in the middle of the walkways – they may get stepped on or someone may fall over them – not good for your dog or the person
- Do not allow your dog to ‘get in another dogs face’ that is a very dangerous way for them to meet – not all dogs are comfortable to that and may react

SMALL DOGS –

When walking in a crowded area, such as vending areas, please carry your tiny one or use a carriage. Many greys have high prey drive and may think your little one is a play toy. Not a good situation for either dog.

CHILDREN

We love children and very happy to see them at *Hugs for Hounds* but there are a few rules for them too:

1. Please do not allow your children to run up to or behind the dogs. Walking quietly is best.
2. Remind your children to never pet a dog without asking the owner first.
3. In the vending areas it can be very tempting for your children to touch and feel the merchandise just as adults do. Please be mindful and watch. We all know little hands can be dirty and we wouldn’t want any vendor merchandise to get soiled and make it unsellable
4. We know how quickly children can get out of our sight so please be keep your children with you at your side at all times and teach them to be aware of their surroundings
